Founded in 1847 to manage the water resources of the Ganges River, the institution carries the mantle of a long and distinguished tradition of teaching and learning.






Strong international character from inception.







VISITING ADVANCED JOINT RESEARCH FACULTY SCHEME



- Aims to bring an international dimension to the R&D ecosystem of India
- To tap the expertise of International Faculty / scientists/technologists including NRI, PIO, OCI in highly competitive areas of research and development by offering them adjunct / visiting faculty positions
- To catalyze possible institutional collaborations through faculty exchange.
- The Faculty will work for minimum of 1 month and a maximum of 3 months a year in an institution in India
- The adjunct position will be offered initially for a period of 1 year, and can be renewed every year.
- The VAJRA Faculty will be provided a lump-sum amount of US \$ 15000 in the first month of engagement in a year and US \$ 10000 pm in the other two months to cover their travel and honorarium


History: International perspective



- In 1955 the department of Water Resources Development and Management (WRDM) was established as an Asian African Centre to honour India's commitment at the Asian African Conference held in Bandung.
- WRDM and the Department of Hydrology run special postgraduate programmes for students of the Afro Asian region.
- These departments has so far trained over 3000 in service engineers and agricultural scientists from 55 countries.
- The courses offered by the Department of Hydrology are presently sponsored by the Government of India and the UNESCO.
- The tradition of being a major educational hub in training students from Asia and Africa is sustained by IIT Roorkee in recent times also. Among IITs, Roorkee hosts most international students.






