#### A Chevening Scholarship includes:

#### To be eligible, you must:

- Be a citizen of a Chevening-eligible country or territory
- Return home for a minimum of two years after completing your Master's degree
- Have completed an undergraduate degree that will enable you to apply for a postgraduate course at a UK university
- · Have at least two years of work experience
- Not have previously studied in the UK through a UK government-funded scholarship
