Pursuing PhD Programmes in Lingnan University

What are the PhD Programmes Offered by Lingnan?

Lingnan University offers PhD programmes⁺ in the following areas:

Arts

Chinese, Cultural Studies, English, History, Philosophy, Translation, and Visual Studies;

Business

Accounting, Decision Sciences, Finance, Information Systems Management, Insurance, International Business, Management, Marketing, and Operations Management;

Social Sciences

Economics, Political Science, Psychology, and Sociology and/or Social Policy.

Across the different disciplines, the University has a considerable strength and depth on topics related to China and Asian Pacific studies.

The normal study period for PhD programmes is three years for candidates who possess a relevant master's degree and four years for candidates without a relevant master's degree.

Collaborative Programmes

What is the Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme (HKPFS)?

Established by the Research Grants Council (RGC) of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) Government, the HKPFS aims at attracting the best and brightest students in the world to pursue their PhD studies in Hong Kong's universities.

Lingnan is one of the universities which can nominate brilliant applicants for the Fellowship award. Each Fellowship awardee will be provided with a Fellowship with an annual stipend of HK\$322,800# and a conference/research-related travel allowance of up to HK\$13,500/year# for a maximum period of three years by the RGC.

In addition, the full tuition fee for a Fellowship awardee^ will be waived by Lingnan for his/her first year of study. For an awardee with a normative study period of four years, the University will offer the same level of Fellowship and conference/research-related travel allowance for his/her fourth year of study.

^Eligible local awardees will be given tuition waiver by the HKSAR Government under the scheme of **Tuition Waiver for Local Research Postgraduate Students** for their normal study period. For details, please visit the RGC website at www.ugc.edu.hk/eng/rgc/funding_opport/tws.html.

How to Apply for the HKPFS?

Application Period: from 1 September to 2 December 2021 (Hong Kong Time 23:59)

Step 1: Submit an Initial Application to RGC

- Apply via the HKPFS admission system for initial application at www.rgc.edu.hk/hkphd by
 1 December 2021 (Hong Kong Time 12:00 noon)
- Obtain a HKPFS Reference Number

Step 2: Submit a Full Application to Lingnan

- Submit a full application directly to Lingnan's electronic system at www.LN.edu.hk/admissions/applyonline/ index-rpg.html by 2 December 2021 (Hong Kong Time 23:59)
- Quote the HKPFS Reference Number assigned by the RGC for verification

Step 3: Settle the Application Fee Online



HKFPS

The University will conduct selection of applicants for its PhD programmes and nominate those outstanding and brilliant ones for the Hong Kong PhD Fellowships. The RGC will set up selection panels to evaluate/assess the nominations submitted by universities.

Those who are nominated but are not finally offered the Fellowship, and those not selected for nomination for the Fellowship, will be given consideration for admission as PhD students at Lingnan taking up places assigned to the University with Postgraduate Studentship awards. The full Postgraduate Studentship for a PhD student will be HK\$18,090/month* (rate subject to annual review). For details of admission criteria, please refer to "Who can Apply?" section.

*To be raised to HK\$18,440/month after confirmation of candidature.

Who can Apply?

Lingnan welcomes applicants from different parts of the world who:

- a) hold a master's degree awarded by a tertiary education institution recognised for this purpose by the University; or
- b) hold a relevant bachelor's degree with first or second class honours or at an equivalent standard, and have registered in a programme of study for a master's degree at a recognised tertiary education institution for at least one year and have evidence of research achievement; or
- c) have obtained an equivalent qualification of a) or b) above; or
- d) have provided satisfactory evidence of academic and professional attainment.

In addition to the above, an applicant whose degree is not from a tertiary institution in Hong Kong or an English-speaking country should obtain a minimum score of 550 (paper-based test) or 79 (internet-based test) in the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), or a band score of 6.5 or above in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS), or an

equivalent score in a recognised test, or an equivalent qualification to prove his/her language proficiency which will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Applicants are required to fulfil additional requirements, if any, set by the programmes to which they apply for admission.

Note:

For IELTS and TOEFL qualifications for admission to 2020-21 intake and onwards, the University only accepts results that are within the validity period, viz. 2 years, from the time of submission of an admission application for the specific intake cohort.

Apart from application for admission via HKPFS, applicants may apply to the University directly, including programmes in collaboration with overseas universities from 1 November 2021 to 21 January 2022. Full-time students will normally be awarded either a PhD Fellowship or a Postgraduate Studentship.





What will You Gain from our PhD Programmes?

Lingnan is a teaching and research liberal arts university. This means that it emphasises both teaching and research. Like many American liberal arts colleges, and like the colleges at Cambridge and Oxford, Lingnan believes that the ethos of liberal arts education requires limited student numbers and an intimate campus setting. One of the key values of liberal arts education is student-centred learning. Student-centred learning ensures close and supportive thesis supervision, while at the same time encourages candidates to exercise

intellectual creativity in their research endeavours.

As the University community is small, familiar and collegial, postgraduate students at Lingnan do not get "lost in the system". They establish peer-type working relationships with academics in their departmental homes; they have generous opportunities to gain undergraduate teaching experience; and they experience a strong sense of membership of a campus-wide postgraduate community.

Financial Support

The University provides the following financial assistance to our PhD students:

A) Fellowships and Studentships

A full-time PhD student will normally be awarded with either a PhD Fellowship or a Postgraduate Studentship. Please see details in earlier sections.

B) Research Postgraduate Student Conference/Field Trip Sponsorships

The Sponsorships aim to provide financial support to students for conference participation and conducting field trips.

The funding limit for supporting conferences, field trips and/or other exceptionally approved academic activities is HK\$25,000 for a regular PhD student during his/her entire period of study. For a PhD Fellowship awardee, he/she can be given a maximum allowance of HK\$13,500/year (rate subject to annual review) for his/her normal study period.

Research Postgraduate Scholarships for Overseas Research Visits

The Scholarships aim to encourage PhD students to undertake a short-term research visit for a term and up to six months normally at an overseas institution and to attract overseas students to come to conduct research at Lingnan for a short period of time.

Depending on the duration and the destination of the visit of the Lingman student/the country from which the overseas student is from, the amount of each Scholarship ranges from HK\$25,000 to HK\$50,000. The Scholarships are offered on a competitive basis.

D) Other Scholarships

Research postgraduate students are also eligible for a number of scholarships, which are normally awarded based on academic merits and recommendation.

About Lingnan University

History

Lingnan is a liberal arts university in Hong Kong and has the longest established tradition among the local institutions of higher education. Its history dates back to 1888 when its forerunner, the prestigious Lingnan University in Guangzhou, China, was founded.

Campus

The University campus is located in the northern part of Tuen Mun and is connected to the central business district in a 40-minute subway ride. It has a total area of about 11 hectares and consists of a main campus and an adjacent secondary housing the University's teaching/support facilities and Outdoor Sports Ground respectively.

Hostels

As a highly residential campus, Lingnan offers affordable accommodation for undergraduate and research postgraduate students in ten hostels on campus with around 2,600 residential places.

Research Strength

As a liberal arts university aspiring to international stature, Lingnan is committed to excellence in both research and teaching. Whilst some liberal arts colleges do not require or pride themselves on a high level of staff research, others have earned—as we do—major research

reputations by encouraging and/or requiring staff research, often on the assumption that such research, far from depleting energies that might otherwise be spent on teaching, in fact nourishes and inspires outstanding teaching.

The results of the Research Assessment Exercise (RAE) 2020 announced by the University Grants Committee (UGC) in May 2021 amply confirmed Lingnan's strength in research, with the following remarkable achievements:

- More than 50% of Lingnan's outputs were rated 4-star ("World Leading") or 3-star ("Internationally Excellent").
- In terms of 4-star plus 3-star outputs, these two Units of Assessment (UoAs) have achieved notable results:
 - Social Work & Social Policy 54% The highest
 - Accountancy 65% Second highest
