4. All notice in respect of this MOU shall be sent by Registered Post to the address of the UOP and the UPO herein before stated.

Amendments:

5. Either party may request changes to this MOU. Any changes, modifications, revisions or amendments to this MOU which are mutually agreed upon by and between the parties to this MOU shall be incorporated by written instrument, and effected when executed and signed by all parties to this MOU.

Entirety of agreement:

6. This MOU represents the entire and integrated MOU between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations and agreements, whether written or oral.

Effective date:

7. The effective date of this MOU is the date of the signature last affixed to this MOU.

Term and termination

- 8. This MOU will be valid and remain in force for a period ofcommencing from......and can be renewed further by mutual consent of the parties, for such period(s) as may be mutually acceptable.
- 9. However either party may terminate this MOU by giving 60 (sixty) days written notice to the other party with or without any reasons whatsoever. Upon termination of the MOU, neither party shall be liable to

the other, either for compensation or for damages of any kind or character whatsoever. The MOU may not be terminated by either party during the course of an on going training cycle.

Confidentiality:

10. This MOU, its existence and all information exchange between the parties under this MOU or during the negotiations preceding this MOU is confidential to them and may not be disclosed to any third person whatsoever. Nestle May, at its discretion, present the program to media for wider publicity.
