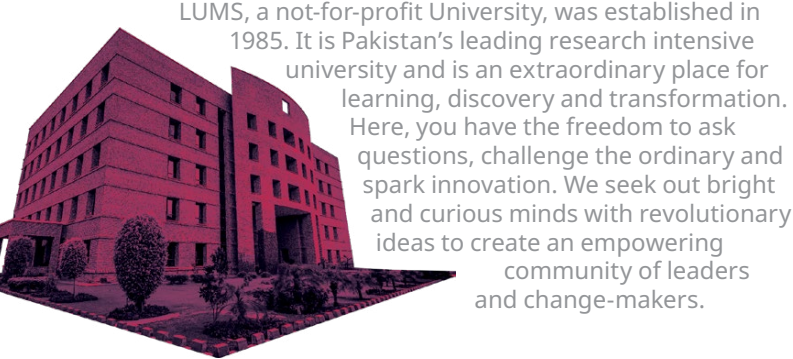


# Welcome to LUMS

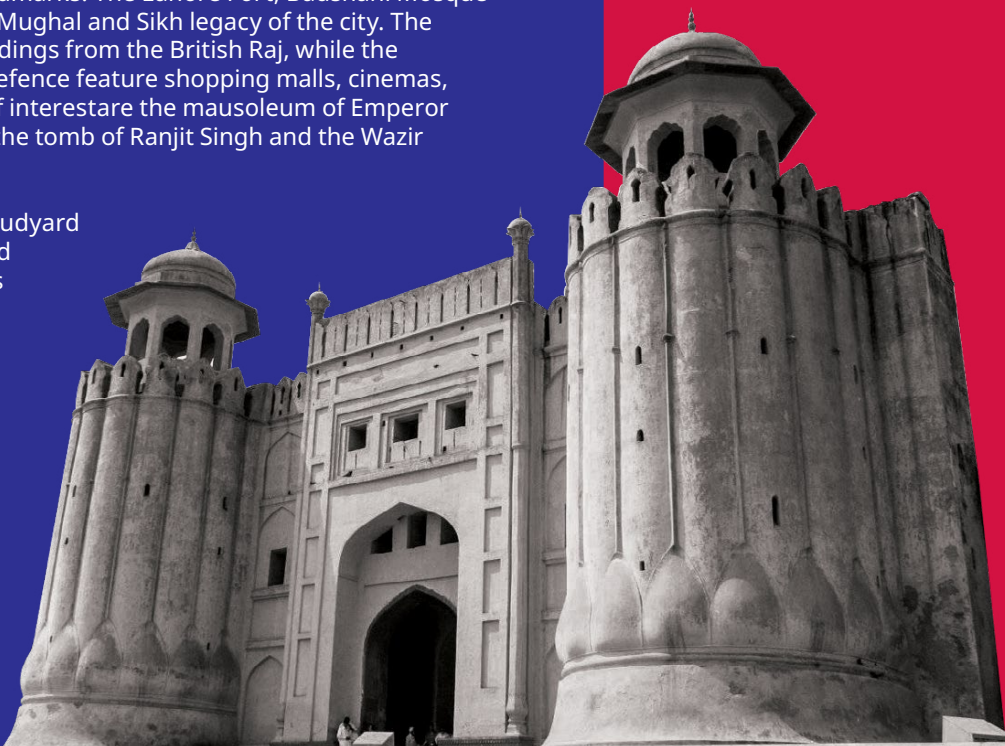
# Life in Lahore: A city of culture

Situated on the banks of the River Ravi, Lahore, Pakistan's second-largest city is the historical, cultural and educational capital of the country. The city has been the cultural capital of the Punjab province for centuries and has seen the comings and goings of many kings, emperors and rulers from different cultures and backgrounds. Lahore has absorbed these diverse influences, achieving a unique sense of history

The city is famous for its historical landmarks. The Lahore Fort, Badshahi Mosque and Gurdwara are a testament to the Mughal and Sikh legacy of the city. The Mall Road is famed for its colonial buildings from the British Raj, while the more modern areas of Gulberg and Defence feature shopping malls, cinemas, restaurants and more. Other places of interest are the mausoleum of Emperor Jehangir, Pearl and Golden Mosques, the tomb of Ranjit Singh and the Wazir Khan Mosque.

Lahore's museum, which features in Rudyard Kipling's Kim, is among the most noted in the East. The old walled city, with its narrow cobbled streets and old houses, is a museum in itself.

With a historical legacy of more than a thousand years, the city has produced countless scholars, poets, writers, intellectuals and scientists. Lahore is thus the centre of higher education in Pakistan. Renowned schools, colleges and universities can be found dotting the city landscape.

## Student Mobility

The Office of International Affairs manages 30+ exchange agreements with partner universities across the globe, with the number of our partners growing extensively. Through these programs, students from our partner universities as well as LUMS are exchanged bilaterally.

### Eligibility Criteria

- Students must have proficiency in English.
- Students must have successfully completed one semester of education with good academic standing within a relevant field of study at their home institution.

Exchange partners nominate their selected students via email. All nominated students will receive an acceptance email/ letter with the application instructions and practical information about the exchange programme at LUMS. Students may complete the application form and send it back via email and courier along with the required documents as follows.

## Student Exchange Guide

### 1. Apply

### 2. Fill Document

### 3. Receive Acceptance

Office of International Affairs LUMS will issue accepted students a welcome letter.
