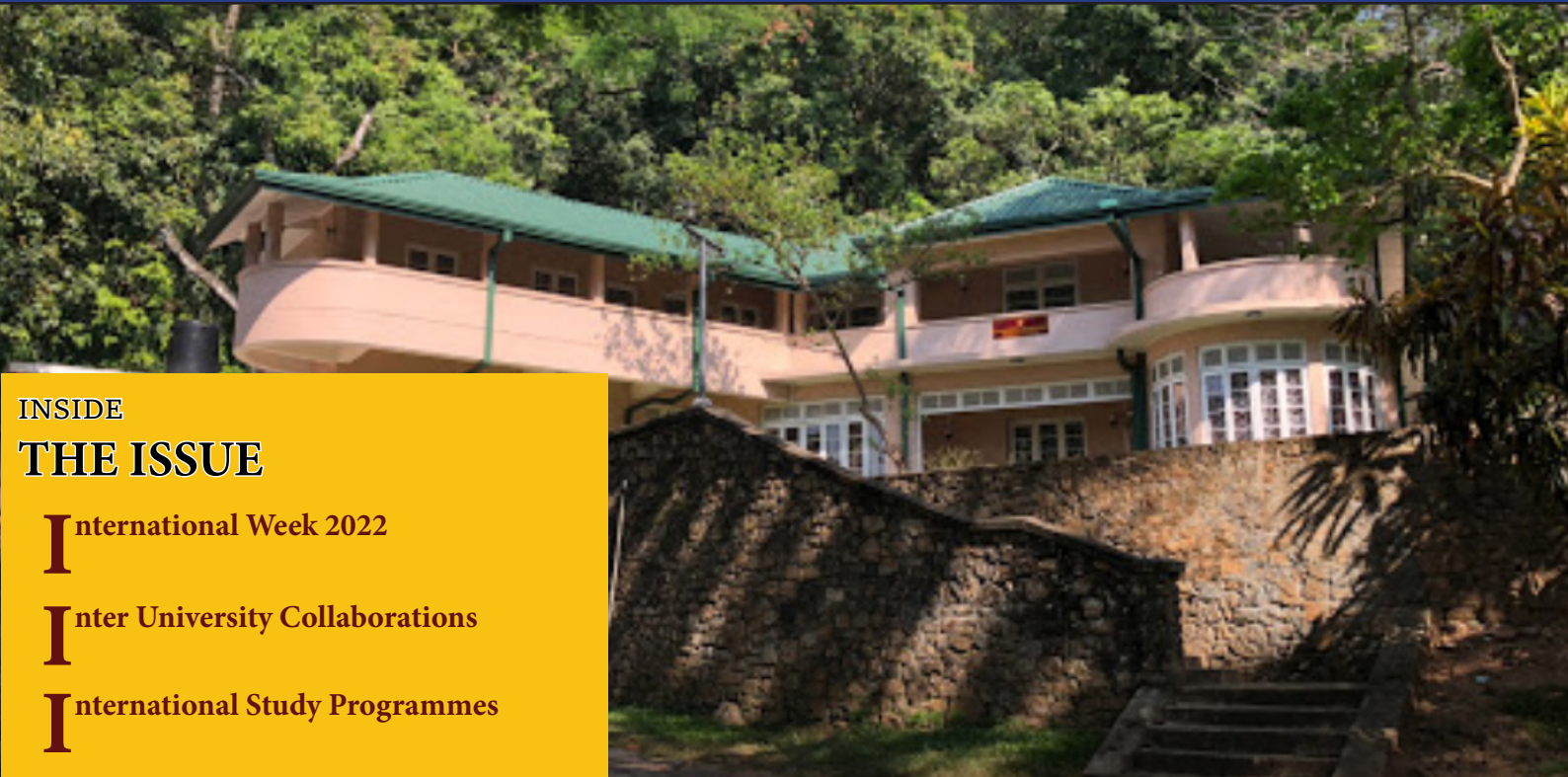

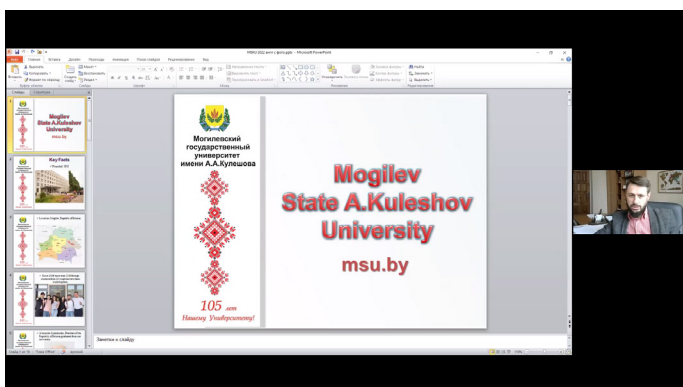

Meeting with Mogilev State A. Kuleshov University, Republic of Belarus

A meeting with Mogilev State A. Kuleshov University, Republic of Belarus was conducted on 1st April 2022 with the participation of Prof. C.N.R.A. Alles, Director, InRO, InRO staff members, and Mr. Sergei Machekin, International Relations Department, Mogilev State A. Kuleshov University, Republic of Belarus.



The objective of the meeting was to introduce the two universities and to explore the possible collaboration between the two parties. Mogilev State A. Kuleshov University expressed its interest in initiating double degree programmers, especially for master's degrees, and to request separate proposals from different faculties for academic collaboration including possible research collaborations and conferences. It was decided to explore the possibilities of conducting online activities, common lectures, and workshops between the two universities. Further, it was decided to sign an MoU between the two universities to strengthen the collaboration and to conduct a second meeting with the relevant faculty staff members. 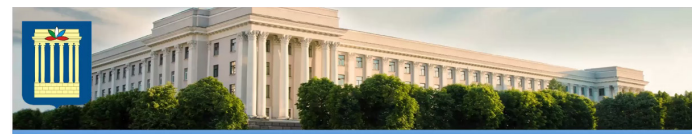


Meeting with Belarusian-Russian University

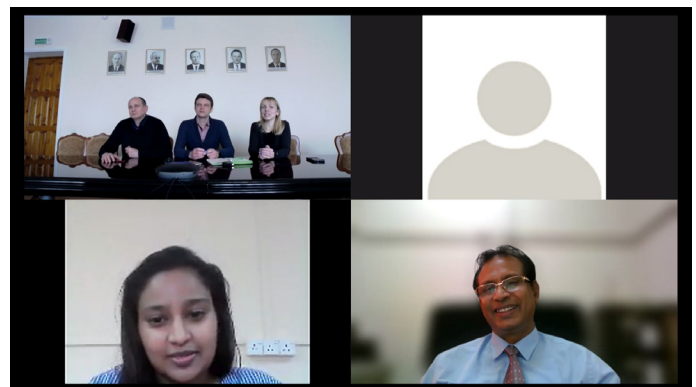

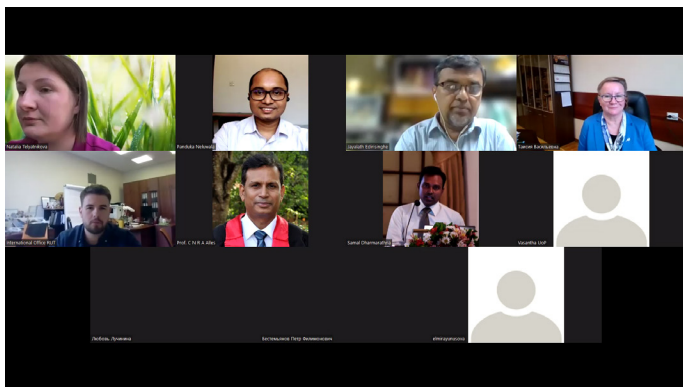

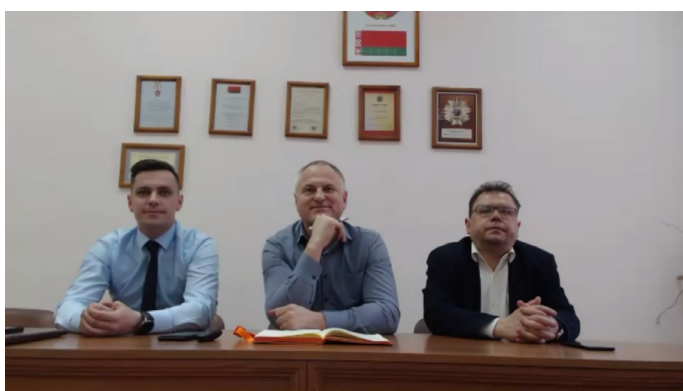
Meeting with Russian University of Transport (MIIT), Russia

The objective of the meeting was to discuss the MoU which is currently processing under the faculty of Engineering and to strengthen the current collaborations. Further, exploring the possibility of research collaborations between two universities was discussed.



Meeting with the Belarus_Veterinary Medicine University

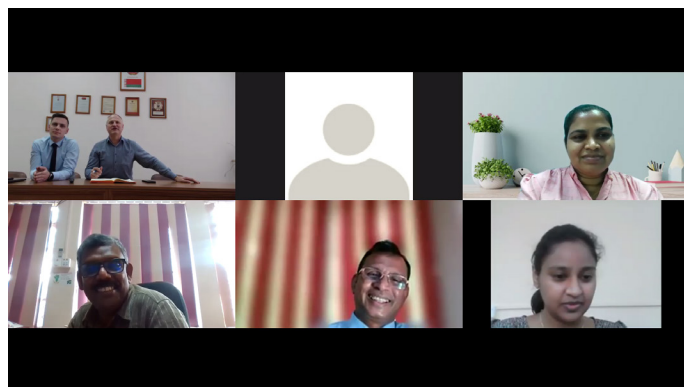

International Cooperation Coordinator, Dr. Denitri, and Dean of international cooperation of Belarus_Veterinary Medicine University participated from the partner university.



The objective of the meeting was to introduce the two universities and to explore the possible collaboration between the two parties. The possibility of having student exchanges free of charge, initiating joint PhDs, and other postgraduate programmes in English were discussed in the meeting. Further, it was decided to

conduct a follow-up meeting to discuss the academic collaborations in detail and to sign an agreement between the two universities to strengthen the collaborations.



Collaboration with the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences

The meeting with Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences was conducted on 25th May 2022, with the participation of Vice Chancellor, Director, InRO, Staff members of the Faculty of Science, Faculty of Agriculture and the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine and Animal Sciences.

The possible areas for research collaborations were presented by the academic staff members and the areas for research collaborations included “Thermochemical conversion of Energy/Bio char and bio oil, Aerobic technology for value added product development, Biomass conversion to energy using anerobic digestive process, Production of improved crop seeds,



Production of flour using different crops, Clinical researches for animals and aquatic organisms, organic fertilizer production, non-conventional starch sources for animal feeding, etc”.

Vice Chancellor instructed to develop a proposal containing possible research collaborations, development of a center for research collaborations with Swedish Universities and to look for opportunities on EU grants for research on Biomolecules and Biomass as well as to proposal on how to establish Swedish Sri Lanka grant scheme for research.

Visit of the Egyptian Ambassador to the University of Peradeniya



The Ambassador of the Arab Republic of Egypt to Sri Lanka and the Maldives, The Honorable Maged Mosleh visited the University of Peradeniya on the 25th of

May 2022. The Ambassador was welcomed by Prof. G. H. Peiris, the Chancellor, Prof. M.D. Lamawansa, the Vice Chancellor, Prof. T. Madujith, the Deputy Vice Chancellor, Dr. E.M.P.C.S. Ekanayake, the Deans of the Faculty of Arts, and Prof. N. Alles, the Director of the International Relations Office, University of Peradeniya. The Vice Chancellor discussed possible future collaborations including research and academic collaborations and exchange between the Arab Republic of Egypt and the University of Peradeniya. The Ambassador Honorable Maged Mosleh conveyed his greetings to the University of Peradeniya and expressed his interest in consolidating strong collaborations with the University of Peradeniya in various fields discussed. Furthermore, his excellency especially expressed his interest in fields such as protecting and maintaining human rights and establishing a center for human rights.



Second Meeting with the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences

A meeting was conducted on 10th June 2022 to develop a proposal to establish a “Research Centre for Biomaterials and Biomass” at the University of Peradeniya & to identify potential research areas for multi-disciplinary research with the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences and other Swedish universities, with the participation of Prof. C. N. R. A. Alles (Director/ International Relations Office), Prof. R. M. G. Rajapakse, Prof. T. M. W. J. Bandara (Faculty of Science), Prof. S. Dharmakeerthi, Dr. A. K. Karunaratne (Faculty of Agriculture), Prof. J. P. A. P. Jayasooriya, Dr. S. S. S. de S. Jagoda, (Faculty of Veterinary Medicine and Animal Science).



Prof. T. M. W. J. Bandara was nominated as the Coordinator and Dr. S.S.S de S. Jagoda was nominated as the secretary of the committee and two subsequent meetings were held regarding the same. Currently, Prof. T. M. W. J. Bandara and Dr. S.S.S de S. Jagoda are working on the proposal to establish a “Research Centre for Biomaterials and Biomass” at the University of Peradeniya followed by the discussions. Furthermore, nine proposals were developed to identify the potential research areas for multi-disciplinary research with the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences, by the above group and the titles and proposals were tabled at the 60th BOM of InRO.

Meeting with Goethe Institute to introduce German Language Course at UoP



A meeting between the Goethe Institute and the Faculty of Arts was conducted on 23rd June 2022 with the participation of Prof. C.N.R.A. Alles, Director, Dr. Dr. E. M. P. C. S. Ekanayake, Dean, Faculty of Arts, Dr. S. Baskaran, Ven. Jambughapitiye Dhammaloka Thero, Acting Head of the Department, Department of Classical Languages and the staff members of InRO. The

Director of the Goethe Institute, Mr. Stefan Winkler participated in the meeting to discuss on introducing the German Language Course to the curriculum of the Faculty of Arts under the Department of Classical Languages. Providing German Language learning materials, Teachers recruiting and training and developing the course content were discussed at the meeting.

Meeting with the Northwest A & F University and the University of Peradeniya



The Meeting between Northwest A & F University and the University of Peradeniya was conducted on 17th June 2022 (Friday) with the participation of the Vice Chancellor of the Northwest A & F University and Prof. C.N.R.A. Alles, Director, InRO. An introductory presentation on the Northwest A & F University was done by the Vice Chancellor of the Northwest A & F University and an introductory presentation on the University of Peradeniya was done by Prof. C. N. R. A. Alles (Director/ International Relations Office).

Academic Collaborations with the Faculty of Medicine, the Faculty of Agriculture, the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine & Animal Science, and the Faculty of Science were discussed at the meeting. The possibility of water quality and water-related research with the Faculty of Engineering and the other relevant Faculties and Staff exchange programs was also discussed. Furthermore, it was decided to conduct a second meeting with the relevant Heads of the Departments and the academic staff members.

Tamil Department's academic visit to India



The academic staff of the Department of Tamil has visited India for building networks with the Indian academic institutions, Training for Junior Academic Staff & visiting places which have heritage values. The team was led by the head of the department Prof. S. Pirashanthan.

Department of Tamil – University of Peradeniya strengthened its relationship with the Tamil University, Thanjavur, India by jointly conducting “Mahakavi Bharathiar Centenary Memorial Research Conference”.



The inauguration ceremony of the International Conference was held on the 30th March at the Seminar room of the Tamil University. Dr. Tamilisai Soundararajan, Governor of Telangana & current Lieutenant Governor of Puducherry – India participated as the Chief Guest of the inauguration event of the “Mahakavi Bharathiar Centenary Memorial Research Conference”. The proceedings of the Research confer-

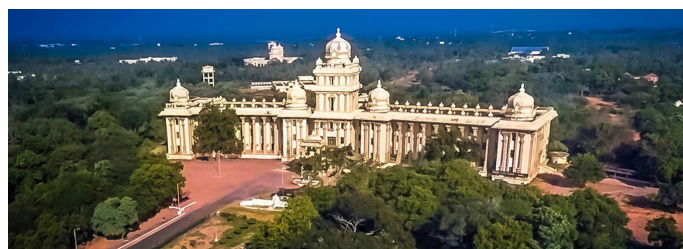
ence were published as a book and it was released at this event. Four sessions were held parallelly, and senior academics & researchers chaired these sessions. Scholars from various parts of India and from other countries participated in these sessions and presented their papers. The research papers presented by the academic staff members of the Department of Tamil – University of Peradeniya were appreciated by several scholars at this event.

Further, the Department of Tamil – University of Peradeniya built a relationship with the Department of Tamil – Madurai Kamaraj University which is one of the 15 universities in India with ‘University with Potential for Excellence’ status which is awarded by the University Grants Commission (UGC) in India, and jointly conducted a research conference on Culture and Classical Tamil Literature. The inauguration ceremony of the conference was held on the 5th of April at the Seminar room of the Madurai Kamaraj University.

The team participated in several other research platforms in various prestigious academic institutions of Tamilnadu. The senior academic staff of the Department gave training to the juniors in Tamil Epigraphy, Inscriptions, Tamil cultural art history & tangible and intangible heritage during this tour. The team returned to the Country on Thursday 7th April 2022 after successfully completing the Indian tour.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Study of the U.S. Institutes (SUSIs) promote a better understanding of the culture, institutions, and people of the United States among foreign students, educators, and scholars. SUSIs are five-to-six week academic programs hosted by educational institutions in the United States. Focusing on various themes in U.S. studies, SUSIs include an intensive academic residency on a U.S. university or college campus and an educational study tour to a different area of the United States.

SCHOLARS AND SECONDARY EDUCATORS

Program Activities

SUSIs for Scholars and Secondary Educators are academic programs for mid-career scholars, professors, practitioners, teachers, and administrators designed to strengthen curricula and improve the quality of teaching about the United States in academic institutions and secondary schools overseas. Participants meet with scholars and experts, interact with diverse American communities, visit civic institutions, and explore U.S. society, culture, values, diversity, and institutions. Each Institute typically hosts 18 to 20 participants from around the globe.

STUDENT LEADERS

Program Activities

SUSIs for Student Leaders are designed for foreign undergraduates to improve their understanding of the United States and develop their leadership skills. The Institutes include an academic residency, leadership development, local community service activities, and interaction with American peers. Twenty students from designated countries participate in each Institute.

Civic Engagement • Comparative Public Policymaking for Pakistan • Education and the Future of Work • Entrepreneurship and Economic Development • Environmental Issues • Journalism and Media • Religious Pluralism in the United States • Rule of Law and Public Service • Young Women Leaders

The Study of U.S. Institutes (SUSIs) are five- to six-week academic programs focusing on topics in U.S. studies for groups of foreign undergraduates, scholars, and teachers. Hosted by universities and colleges throughout the United States, the Institutes include an intensive academic residency, an educational study tour to another region of the United States, and opportunities for participants to engage with American peers. Institutes for Student Leaders also include community service activities and leadership development.

DAAD - Scholarship - For Masters & PhDs



The German Academic Exchange Service, or DAAD, was founded in 1925 and is the largest German support organisation in the field of international academic co-operation. In Sri Lanka DAAD is having its operations together with the German Embassy of Sri Lanka and Maldives.

In 2020, DAAD received the highest recorded number of PhD applications for Research grants (Doctoral Programs in Germany) and Bi Nationally supervised doctoral degrees from Sri Lanka and many scholarship grants open for this year as well.

Master Degree in Germany

How do I go about applying?

It is advisable to start your preparations about a year in advance.

Step 1

Collect information from the DAAD, internet and brochures. Attend DAAD information sessions or webinars. Details about our information events are available on www.daad-sri-lanka.org.

Step 2

Contact the selected university. This will be your most important source of information as far as exact details about eligibility, course duration, fee, application procedure etc. are concerned. Study programmes may have winter semester (October – March) or summer semester (April – September) intakes. Check the application deadline.

Step 3

The website of the course / university you have chosen will carry details about application procedure to be followed. Accordingly, send your application either to the university or to uni-assist. Uni-assist is a body that accepts your application, screens it and forwards it to its member universities of your choice against payment. Member universities of uni-assist often do not entertain direct applications. Please check www.uni-assist.de/en/ for the list of member universities.

Step 4

Apply for a student visa as soon as you have the admission letter, as the procedure can take 8 to 12 weeks. To find out where you should apply for a visa, visit the website of the German Embassy. Proof of funding for the first year of studies is required.

Arrange for accommodation. The International Office of the university can be of help.

Step 5

Arrive in Germany at least a week before your course begins. Contact the International Office of your university for further guidance. Get your residence permit within the first three months of your stay in Germany from the Foreigners' Registration Office.

How can I apply for a DAAD PhD scholarship?

Step 1

Collect information about the scholarship from our website and check the eligibility criteria.

Step 2

Once you have the letter of acceptance from your supervisor/admission letter from your university, complete the scholarship application procedure. The application deadline falls in October of the current year for a PhD beginning October next year.

Step 3

Shortlisted applicants from Sri Lanka will be invited for an interview. The final decision will be announced around March/April.

Step 4

Once selected, you will attend a mandatory German language course, which is an important part of your scholarship.

Step 5

After the successful completion of your language course in Germany, your PhD will begin in October.

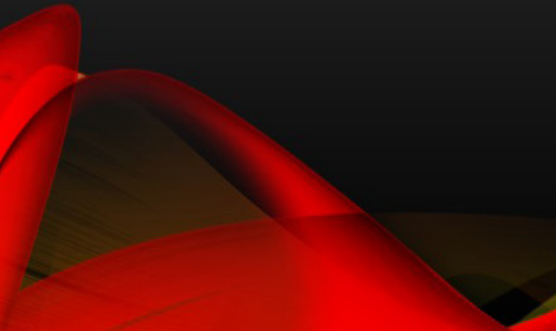
