
Meeting with Northwest A& F University - China

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#### Meeting with Institute of Asian and African Studies, Lomonosov Moscow State University, Russia

Following the letter received to us from Lomonosov Moscow State University (IAAS MSU) through you, we were able to conduct the initial meeting between Lomonosov Moscow State University (IAAS MSU) and the University of Peradeniya on 12th July 2022, with



the participation of Mr. Chamila Jayarathna, Minister Counsellor and Ms. Julia Belyaeva, Interpreter from the Embassy and Alexey Maslov, Professor, Acting Director, Ekaterina Sintsova, Deputy Director for International Cooperation, Boris Zakharyin, Head of the Department of Indian Philology, Aleksandra Safronova, Head of the Department of South Asian History and Boris Volkhonskiy, Associate Professor, Department of Indian Philology from Lomonosov Moscow State University. Dr. Darshani Gunathilake - Head of the Department of Sinhala, Dr. Sudesh Mantillake - Head of the Department of Fine Arts, and Dr. W. M. S. M. Kumari Thoradeniya - Head of the Department of Sociology participated in the meeting from the Faculty of Arts.



Discussions were conducted on initiating joint undergraduate and postgraduate courses on Sinhala Language and Culture, History, International Relations, Buddhist Studies, etc, and conducting student and staff exchanges between the two universities. A special concern was given to developing some courses for the above subjects which the Russian students can visit and study at the University of Peradeniya. Furthermore, the potential of developing joint research projects on the above subject areas was discussed. Both parties have expressed interest in organizing joint seminars, webinars, and workshops, and also the Lomonosov Moscow State University expressed their interest in participating in the International Week which has been planned to conduct at the end of November by the International Relations Office.

It was decided to prepare a plan including the potential activities and programmes by the Faculty of Arts of the UoP before arranging the second meeting and decided to arrange the follow-up meeting as soon as the plan is prepared.

# Meeting between Japan International Cooperation Agency and the University of Peradeniya on the Certificate Course on Japan's Modernization - Jica Chair Program 2022

The Japan International Cooperation Agency (hereinafter referred to as "JICA") and the University of Peradeniya (hereinafter referred to as "UoP") exchanged views and had a series of discussions with respect to the measures to be taken by both parties for the successful implementation of the "Certificate Course on Japan's Modernization - JICA CHAIR Program" (hereinafter referred to as "the Programme") on 19th July 2022 with the participation of the Director, Sri Lanka Japan Study Centre, Director, InRO and other staff members of the University of Peradeniya and the delegates from the Japan International Cooperation Agency.

The objective of the programme is to educate students and other interested parties on Japan's modernization process, socio-economic-political aspects, and approach to international cooperation will be disseminated among course participants, while participants

make efforts to utilize the accumulated knowledge more widely and openly. The Program will be organized and jointly implemented by International Relations Office (hereinafter referred to as InRO) and SJSC of the University of Peradeniya as the executing agency in coordination with the JICA Sri Lanka office and SLAAJ, with the support of the Coordination Unit of Internships, Volunteering, and Community Outreach.



#### Collaborations with U15 Universities in Canada

With reference to the letter received through the Vice Chancellor from the University Grant Commission on 9th July 2022, the International Relations Office formed a group of scholars consisting of Canadian-trained academics and other interested staff members of the UoP, and conducted an online meeting on 20th July, according to the instructions given by the Vice Chancellor, with the participation of Prof. C.N.R.A. Alles, Director, InRO, Prof. Ruwan Jayasinghe, Dr. Namalika Karunaratne, Ms. Subashini Weerakotuwa, Dr. Thushari Gunawardana, and Dr. Eranga Seram.

Prof. Ruwan Jayasinghe of the Faculty of Dental Sciences was appointed as the team leader, while Dr. Thushari Gunawardana, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine and Animal Sciences was appointed as the coordinator to prepare an overall proposal, with the support of the appointed team from the University of Peradeniya. The proposal prepared by the committee was submitted to the Vice Chancellors office and requested to forward to the relevant authorities for further action.

#### Meeting to develop the proposal on International Week- 2022



An online meeting between the International Relations Office and Dr. Ruwantha Kulathunga, Head of the Departement, Department of Classical Languages was conducted on 28th July 2022. Prof. C.N.R.A. Alles, Director, InRO, and the staff members of InRO participated in the meeting. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the proposal for International Week 2022 developed by the InRO to identify the gaps and to get comments and suggestions from an external party to improve the proposal.

#### Meeting with Swedish Delegate

As per the instructions given at the initial meeting held with the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences on the 25th of May 2022 at the Senate Room,



a meeting was called on 10th June 2022 to develop a proposal to establish a "Research Centre for Biomaterials and Biomass" at the University of Peradeniya & to identify potential research areas for multi-disciplinary research with the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences and other Swedish universities, with the participation of Prof. CNR A Alles (Director/International Relations Office) Prof. R M G Rajapakse, Prof. T M W J Bandara (Faculty of Science) Prof. S Dharmakeerthi, Dr. A K Karunarathne (Faculty of Agriculture) Prof J P A P Jayasooriya, Dr. S S S de S Jagoda (Faculty of Veterinary Medicine and Animal Science). Prof. T M W J Bandara was nominated as the Coordinator and Dr. S.S.S de S. Jagoda was nominated as the secretary of the committee and two subsequent meetings were held regarding the same.

Furthermore, nine proposals were developed to identify the potential research areas for multi-disciplinary research with the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences, by the above group and the titles and proposals were tabled at the 60th BOM of InRO.

A meeting was conducted on 12th August with the participation of the Vice Chancellor, Deputy Vice Chancellor, Director, InRO, the above team, and the visiting Professor Dinesh Fernando from the Swedish Agriculture University. Currently, Prof. T M W J Bandara and Dr. S.S.S de S. Jagoda are working on the proposal to establish a "Research Centre for Biomaterials and Biomass" at the University of Peradeniya followed by the discussions.

#### Meeting with Northwest A & F University – China



An online meeting was conducted with Northwest A & F University, China, on 23rd August 2022 with the participation of Dr. Nadeeka Jayawardena, Faculty of

Agriculture, Dr. Thilini Anupama, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine and Animal Sciences, Dr. Panduka Neluwala, Faculty of Engineering, Prof. C.N.R.A. Alles, Director, InRO and Ms. S.K. Tennakoon, Project Manager, InRO. Mr. LIU Xuebo, Director, Office of International Cooperation and Exchange, Mr. QIAO Zhe, Deputy Director, Office of International Cooperation and Exchange, Mr. Hai Jiangbo, Professor, College of Agronomy, Mr. Huan Jinlian, Professor, College of Veterinary Medicine, Ms. Wu Jiangwei, Professor, College of Animal Science, and Mr. Xu Jinghui, Professor, College of Water Resources and Architectural Engineering were participated for the meeting from the Northwest A & F University, China.

The objective of the meeting was to introduce the two universities and to explore the possible collaboration between the two parties. Northwest A & F University, China expressed its interest in initiating collaborative programmes, and to request separate proposals from different faculties for academic collaboration including possible research collaborations and conferences. It was decided to explore the possibilities of conducting online activities, common lectures, and workshops between the two universities. Further, it was decided to sign an MoU between the two universities to strengthen the collaboration and to conduct a second meeting with the relevant faculty staff members.

#### Meeting with Coursera



An online meeting was conducted with Coursera - Asia, on 24 th August 2022 with the participation of Mr. Aditya Naik, Enterprise Director, Coursera, Prof. C.N.R.A. Alles, Director, InRO, Ms. S.K. 


# Russian State Hydrometeorological University (RSHU) meeting
