# Visit of Prof. Joe Rubin from the University of Saskatchewan, Canada

Prof. Joseph Rubin from Western College of Veterinary Medicine, University of Saskatchewan, Canada visited UoP from 04<sup>th</sup> to 07<sup>th</sup> March 2024. Prof. Rubin's visit to Sri Lanka was supported by a grant from the University of Saskatchewan titled "Building microbiology laboratory capacity and sharing educational resources: a USask – Sri Lanka collaboration". Dr. Ro-



shan Madalagama from the Veterinary Research Institute (VRI) is the principal local counterpart for this project.



Prof. Rasika Jinadasa and Prof. Anurudhdhika Dissanayake from the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine & Eamp; Animal Science are the collaborators from UoP. Prof. Rubin met with the Deputy Vice-Chancellor, Dr. Madalagama, Prof. Jinadasa, and Dr. Gayani Weerasooriya, (Deputy Director VRI) on 07th March.





During this visit to UoP, Prof. Rubin conducted 3 public lectures and discussed with academic staff developing open-source teaching material and evaluation and assessment of the veterinary microbiology course. He shared the entire electronic open-source



teaching material for his veterinary microbiology course with UoP students. He also donated a copy of Green Infectious Diseases of Dog & Cat to the Veterinary Medicine Library. Additionally, Dr. Rubin conducted several training programs for VRI staff scientists and Veterinary Investigation Officers, including visits to Northern and Eastern provinces to develop advanced competencies in microbiology and antimicrobial stewardship during this visit.

The broader goal of this project is poverty and hunger reduction through building local capacity to address infectious disease challenges in Sri Lanka livestock, improving food security, and reducing the impact of antimicrobial resistance. This initiative will also be used as an opportunity to build bridges between faculty at the Vet School at the University of Peradeniya and the University of Saskatchewan and discuss joint programming needs and open educational resources.


















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
